Please do not bring your dog if the following apply to you;

- You, or any member of your family have any symptoms relating to Covid 19. Common symptoms are: fever, tiredness, dry cough. Some people may experience; loss of taste, aches and pains, nasal congestion, runny nose, sore throat, diarrhoea.
- You have visitors in your home from outside the Wanganui area who have been with you for less than 14 days.

Personal safety

- If you arrive at the same time as another owner, please wait in your car until they get back into theirs.
- Do maintain social distancing if you should meet another person 2 metres physically apart.
- Do not shake hands or have any physical contact.
- Do cough/sneeze into elbows if you need to do so.
- Do not touch any shared surfaces other than door and gate handle.
- PAYMENT We would prefer that you pay by direct banking and not use the EFTPOS machine or cash. If this is not possible just let us know and we deal with each request on an individual basis. At Drop off - Please wait in your car and keep an eye on members of staff

- You will be directed to take your dog to one of the 3 gates we usually take your dog through; These are
 - 1) The Little Paddock at the front of the building
 - 2) The Big Paddock on the right as you drive into the carpark
 - 3) Into the building through the porch
- When directed both you and your dog can come <u>INSIDE</u> the area you are directed to. Close the gate/door behind you.
- If asked to bring your dog <u>inside</u> the building pop them through the door and close it behind them.
- Take the lead off (you can leave the collar on) and wait for us to call the dog to us before you open and exit the gate/door you came in through.

TAKE YOUR LEAD HOME WITH YOU and bring it back later :)

Drop off /Pick up times will take a little longer than usual; please respect other owners and please don't stop to catch up with friends or staff members. Patience must be practiced but not imposed upon others.



Pick Up time - Please wait in your car and keep an eye on members of staff

- We will tell you which gate your dog will come to you through
- IMPORTANT Please come INSIDE the outer gate and close it behind you We will then send your dog to you.
- Place your dog on the lead, you have brought back, and leave. Please ensure the gate is closed firmly behind you.

Contact Tracing

- VACCINATION booklet we <u>DO NOT</u> need to see it if nothing has changed since we saw it last.
- We will update our Contact Tracing system with; your name, address, telephone number, date and times of your visits.

Throughout the day ...

- We will disinfect door handles and gate catches regularly.
- We will remain at least 2m away from each other and our clients and will remain in our own areas of the building when inside.
- We will disinfect your dog's collar.
